The New York State Public Employees Federation, representing 59,000 Professional, Scientific, and Technical workers of New York State, supports this legislation.

This bill provides for an appeals process on applications made to the Director of the Classification and Compensation Division if not approved within 120 days.

This bill amends the Civil Service Law to require that a decision on an application be made by the Director within 120 days of submission. If no decision is made, an employee can make a written appeal to the State Civil Service Commission no sooner than 120 days and no later than 150 days after the application was submitted.

This expedites the application procedure to make sure all applications are reviewed, and gives consideration to agency planning purposes by making the Director review all applications within a certain time.

For these reasons, the Public Employees Federation urges you to support this legislation.
